This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Fresh Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 10 only. Any further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law subject to availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension

2	The library is not developed as per Board guidelines vide circular dated 04/10/2022 (SOP- recommended infrastructure and facilities in the Labs, Library and Sports). The school has placed small tables and chair for readers and no separate seating arrangement for teachers and staff also available. The accession and stock register is also not properly maintained for proper library operations. The school is directed to follow the circular no. 11/2022 and develop the library as per the SOP and make compliance on SARAS Portal within 3 months with videography link.
3	The school is directed to develop the Composite Science lab with recommended infrastructure as per the Board Guidelines and SOP on infrastructure and facilities in the composite science lab. The seating arrangement is not sufficient and the lab lacks in the recommended standard safety measures including provision for emergency exit door, first aid kit. The plastic item like tray / rack should not be made available in the science lab due to heating facility and inflammable chemicals which may be fatal and hazardous. The school is directed to upgrade the composite lab as per SoPs and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal with videography LINK.
4	The CWSN facilities and infrastructure is not as per the RPwD act 2016 and the Board guidelines vide circular no. 5/2023 to make the campus accessible in compliance of statutory provisions. CwSN toilets are not made available at each floor. Further, side grab bars/support handles are not made available in the CwSN toilets. School should arrange the CwSN toilets and facilities at each floor separately for Boys and Girls with permanent signage and should follow the circular no 05/2023. The compliance should be uploaded on SARAS portal with video link within 03 months.
5	School is not having the separate Boundary on all sides as per Board guidelines for safety of students. On one side, a common wall with the adjoining building is reported by the inspection committee which is not acceptable as the school is required to be bounded by a 6 ft height separate boundary wall from all sides for safety purposes. The school is directed to raise the height of wall on the sides adjoining the other property/building and upload the compliance on SARAS Portal with video link within 3 months.
6	As per inspection report, the schools has taken a playground under lease agreement from Greater Hyderabad Municipal corporation for making for arrangements of outdoor sports activities. As the said land is not adjoining to the school building campus making it safe and contiguous area under single boundary wall, it cannot be permitted for use by the school for outdoor sports activities due to safety of the students. The school is directed to upgrade the outdoor sports infrastructure in the school premises by adding other sports activities as per circular no. 5/2023 and report the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
7	The school is directed to ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from COE, CBSE Vijyawada within 3 months and make the compliance on SARAS Portal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
